Halton Swimming Club resides in the Borough of Halton, Cheshire, England.

We are situated close to the famous Cities of Liverpool (*10 miles – Home of Liverpool & Everton Football Club, the Beatles*), Manchester (*30 miles – Home of Manchester United & City Football Clubs*) and the historic City of Chester (*20 miles - Roman Walls, Buildings, Shops and Racecourse*).

With the continuing success of our meet we are pleased to put this swimming completion on again I'm please to invite you all to our third Masters Swim Meet, we are again inviting teams from all our twin towns and the European community. The event is not limited to the above and we welcome all applications from competitors who wish to travel to Halton and compete in this meet either as a team or an individual.

The event is planned to be held at our 8 lane, 25mtr competition pool at our base, Kingsway Leisure Centre, Widnes, Halton, Cheshire. The meet will consist of 50mtr & 100mtr events in each stroke and will include a 100mtr & 200mtr Individual Medley with a 400mtr freestyle event.

We will also include Team events of 4x50mtr Freestyle & Medley Relays for both male and female with a 6x50mtr mixed cannon relay to complete the day.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the promoter.
- Age Groups:**
- Ages as at the 31/12/10 except group “x” swimmers who should have reached the age of eighteen on or before the date of competition
- Entry Requirements:**
- All competitors are to be fully registered with their respected National Swimming Association or Federation. (*for insurance purposes*)
- Individual Events:**
- All individual events are seeded, so that you will swim against others of similar speed regardless of age. Races will be heat declared winners, Results will be decided on the recorded heat times in each age group
- Individual Competitor:**
- A competitor must be a member of the club he/she represents and may only swim for one club during the competition.
- Swim Conditions:**
- The one start rule will apply.  
Over the top starts will be used if required on the day
- Entry Confirmation:**
- No Card System  
Confirmation of entry will be posted on the Halton Swimming Club web site after the closing date with details of their submitted events and times. If you do not have access to the internet and would like to receive confirmation of accepted entries, please enclose a stamped addressed envelope with your entry form. Competitors should check the confirmation of accepted entries carefully. Most errors can be corrected prior to the meet. It is most unlikely that errors will be corrected on the day.  
On the day of the gala, swimmers will find the heats and lanes posted on the poolside walls. Swimmers should make themselves available for their race at least two events prior and confirm their identity with the timekeeper.
- Presentations:**
- Individual Medals will be awarded to the first three swimmers of each age group, in each event. Medals will also be awarded to the individual members of winning relay teams. The medals will be available throughout the day from the nominated desk.
- The top visiting club trophy will go to the club with the highest total of points from the gala, the points will be awarded for individuals and relay teams as follows: - 1st 8 points, 2nd 6 points, 3rd 5 points, 4th 4 points, 5th 3 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 2 points, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> and any swimmer or team who legally finishes their event 1 point.
- Disputes:**
- Any matters not provided for in these conditions and notes shall be decided by the promoters
- Social Evening:**
- There will be a social held locally for all competitors and friends wishing to attend the evening event with a hot buffet and live music. (Vegetarian food will be available on the night).
